Clothing Policy

The goals of this policy are:

- To provide a consistent minimum standard of clothing across PYV Camps and Events
- To ensure clothing is appropriate to conditions it is being worn
- To encourage a helpful standard amongst youth

It is the policy of PYV that:

- Minimum attire on top is a t-shirt
- Shirts that reveal midriff or cleavage are not permitted.
- Minimum attire on bottom is shorts. Shorts, skirts or dresses should be at or below fingertips when standing with arms hanging normally at the side.
- Skin tight items should only be worn with something over the top. (Unless required for certain sporting activities.)
- Closed toe shoes will be required for all activities
- Hats are required for camps and events in Spring, Summer, and Autumn.
- During activities that require swimming, everyone is encouraged to dress appropriately. On top of bathers, both men and women are required to wear a t-shirt and shorts at minimum.

Please know that leaders will be prepared to ask campers to get changed if deemed necessary.

PYV Leaders and other adult guests are expected to set an example in the way they dress. Leaders will also be asked to get changed if necessary.

Campers are free to express concerns to a leader or the camp convenor about clothing worn by leaders that is inconsistent with this policy.
